- The Advanced Composition requirement can be met in one of the following ways: (1) by achieving a grade of "A" or "B" in English Composition I, and a grade of "A" in English Composition II; (2) by providing proof of credit earned by CLEP or departmental exams in English for both Compositions I & II (must appear on college transcript).
- College Algebra or its equivalent is required by Arkansas State Law.
